Location

Rostock provides all the requirements necessary in the field of logistics. The Hanseatic city is the **economic hub in the North East of Germany** and a multimodal junction. The city offers **hundreds of years of experience** in trade and an ideal infrastructure. Berlin and Hamburg can be reached via highway within 2 h. The Rostock-Laage airport and the railway network facilitate the international trade at its best. The main hub of cargo shipping is **Rostock seaport**. The "swimming highway" builds a link to Scandinavia and the Baltic States as well as Russia.

City of the 4 Ports

Seaport Rostock

- ▶ Deepest German seaport in the Baltic (14.5 m)
- ▶ Easy approach (only 3.6 nautical miles)
- ▶ One of the biggest German seaports in the Baltic (750 ha)
- ▶ Berths of all kinds, including one multifunctional pier
- ▶ Regular ferry connection to Scandinavia and the Baltic States (more than 9,400 port calls per year)
- ▶ Annual turnover of bulk cargo: more than 11 mill tons
- ▶ Over 150 resident companies
- ▶ Broad reserve area for new construction and expansion in the vicinity of the quayline
- ▶ Regular shuttle trains to Southern and Western Europe (25 block trains)

Fishingport

- ▶ bulk cargo, general cargo, heavy cargo
- ▶ 1.2 km quayline
- ▶ Broad storage areas (52,000 sqm)
- ▶ Cold storage house (12,000 t capacity)
- ▶ Access to public railway network
